

Holiday On Martay Terms and Conditions of Entry

General

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of the Terms and Conditions of Entry. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. 2. To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other reference to this competition, these Terms and Conditions prevail.

Who can enter

- 3. Subject to the clauses below, entry is open to all residents of New South Wales,
 Queensland and Victoria who have fulfilled the requirements set out below ('Eligible
 Entrants'). Entrants must be over the age of 16, as of the date of entry.
- 4. Employees, and their immediate families, of the Promoter, associated agencies and companies, contractors or individuals are not eligible to enter this competition. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, defacto spouse, child or step child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or 1st cousin.

How to enter

- 7. Open, Close, Draw and Publish dates

- 11. The competition commences on 15/12/2024 at 12:01 AM and closes 15/02/2025 at 11:59 PM ('Promotional Period'). All times noted in these Terms and Conditions are local times, based on the location of the Promoter. If any draw date falls on a public holiday, as defined in the state of the Promoter, that draw will be conducted on the next business day. Entries must be received by the Promoter prior to the competition close date and time.
- 12. Subject to clause 16, the three (3) winners will be the first three valid entry drawn electronically at Promoter's Premises at 60840 Bruce Hwy, Friday Pocket QLD 4855 on 16/02/2025 at 11:00 AM. The winner will get a chance to win the major prize.
